May Pang has been synonymous with the Beatles for over 40 years, having worked for Allen Klein/ABKCO, Apple Records and John Lennon and Yoko Ono as their personal assistant and production coordinator of their records and films. In 1973 the relationship took a personal turn as Lennon left Ono for Pang. For 18 months, Lennon and Pang lived, worked and traveled together during which time Pang worked on three of Lennon's albums; one of which garnered Lennon's only #1 single (Whatever Gets You Thru the Night) and a #1 album (Walls and Bridges). Besides being an executive at Apple Corps, Ltd. and Allen Klein's ABKCO Industries, she worked at Island Records, United Artists Music Publishing & more. She's written several books about her time with Lennon — including the autobiographical *Loving* John and a book of personal photos called *Instamatic Karma*. She is also a jewelry designer, an advocate on environmental issues, animal rights, and women's empowerment and minority issues.
